Both the Bengali Department of Pragjyotish College and Radha Govinda Baruah College agree that any information which is exchanged pursuant to this MoU will be kept strictly confidential and used solely for the purpose, covered by this MoU, unless such information was obtained by a third party who does not have an obligation of confidentiality toward the information-disclosing party and entered public domain.

Subject to clauses below, both the Institutions may attend this MoU by mutual consent in writing. Any amendment agreed by the Institutions shall come into effect from the date determined by the signing Institutions on potential areas.

This MoU shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall initially be valid for a period of three years. Thereafter, the Institutions, that is Pragjyotish College and Radha Govinda Baruah College, shall agree on mutual consent on the continued validity of this MoU. However, Bengali Department of Radha Govinda Baruah College has freedom to continue or discontinue the MoU at its own discretion.

In any other circumstance, or other detailed collaboration between the two parties, a separate MoA shall be drawn up as and when required.





1.1. The term "Commencement" shall mean the date of signing of agreement.


1.2. The term "Centre" shall mean the Computerized Accounting Training Centre at College premises.

- ii. The College shall provide Electricity, internet facility and power back up facility in the college premises for the smooth conduct of the courses.
- iii. The College shall provide the computers to be used by the students of the course for their training and shall be responsible for the maintenance.
- iv. The Second Party shall look after the maintenance of classrooms and computers during ongoing of the course.

3. ACADEMIC COMMITTEE:

An academic committee shall be formed by First Part to monitor the syllabus, progress of the course and fees structure as may be presently applicable including any increase.

4. ACADEMIC EXECUTION:
